Commonly Confused Words: Won vs. One

The words *one* and *won* don't look alike, but they sound alike. Since they sound alike, they are sometimes mixed up.

Won is a verb that is the past tense of *win*.

Example: He **won** the race.

One is a noun that means the number 1 or *a single person or thing*. It may also be used as an adjective.

Example: She bought **one** apple at the store.

One is also used in formal writing as a pronoun.

Example: In class **one** must never talk without permission.
